Martha Ann Hull Anderson my dwelling house and the appurtenances thereto for natural life and after her death it shall, should she have heirs to them their natural life and should she die without any, then to her other sister viz. Elizabeth Anderson the daughter of Henry Anderson and her heirs forever. so as to be understood that the above named property shall remain in the family from heir to heir and not to be sold.

Also we will and bequeath to Elizabeth Anderson the coffee farm situate near the grave yard containing eight acres adjoining Daniel Johnston farm lands near the said place - her natural life and after her death to her childrens children and should she die without heirs the same shall revert to her sister Martha Hull Anderson and after her death to her childrens children forever.

Also we will and bequeath to the son of Henry Anderson viz. Amos Anderson twelve acres adjoining James Bantoms farm lands and the appurtenances thereto belonging and also twelve acres formally belonging to Sawrances estate near the false Cape to his childrens children forever.

I will observe that all of our property shall remain in the hands of our family so long as one can be found.
